TITLE: Counselor

RESPONSIBLE TO: Head Counselor, Assistant Director, Director

PURPOSE: To provide leadership for a small group of campers.

OUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Committed Christian with a willingness to accept the teachings of the Church of the Brethren.
- 2. Exhibit a spirit of cooperation and commitment to a team relationship with other camp staff.
- 3. Personable style and skills in relating to staff, guests, and campers.
- 4. Skills in group management.
- 5. Knowledge of age characteristics for specific groups.
- 6. Be at least two years older than the campers you are supervising.
- 7. Training and/or experience in small group camping and outdoor living skills. Enjoy the outdoors.
- 8. Attendance at one or more pre-camp training events.
- 9. Acceptance of Counselor's responsibilities.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Live with a small group of 6-8 campers in a cabin or hogan.
- 2. Share leadership responsibilities for a family group (usually coed) of 12-16 campers with a co-counselor.
- 3. Provide primary supervision for campers assigned to your group.
- 4. Greet campers and parents on opening day. Help campers to settle in and adjust.
- 5. Implement group schedule and plan additional activities with your co-counselor and campers.
- 6. Guide campers' participation in individual, group, and all-camp activities.
- 7. Practice good group building methods.
- 8. Prepare daily devotions for your group with your co-counselor.
- 9. Help to plan and implement all-camp activities.
- 10. Participate in a weekly evaluation with the Head Counselor and/or Assistant Director.
- 11. Know the contents of the Staff Manual and abide by all camp policies and procedures.
- 12. Enforce camp policies, procedures, and health and safety regulations.
- 13. Assist in other areas of camp operation as needed.
