TITLE: Kitchen Assistant

RESPONSIBLE TO: Kitchen Manager, Director

PURPOSE: To assist the Kitchen Manager in providing food service during the summer camp program.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Committed Christian with a willingness to accept the teachings of the Church of the Brethren.
- 2. Exhibit a spirit of cooperation and commitment to a team relationship with other camp staff.
- 3. Personable style and skills in relating to staff, guests, and campers.
- 4. Willingness to learn new skills.
- 5. Able to adapt to varied situations that arise.
- 6. Able to follow and accurately adjust recipes according to group size.
- 7. Attendance at one or more pre-camp training events.
- 8. Acceptance of Kitchen Assistant's responsibilities.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assist the Kitchen Manager in planning, preparing, and serving attractive meals in a timely manner.
- 2. Safely and correctly operate all kitchen equipment necessary for food preparation, service, and cleaning.
- 3. Assist the Kitchen Manager in keeping the kitchen and dining room clean and sanitary.
- 4. Set-up dish collection area before each meal and wash, dry, and put away dishes after each meal.
- 5. Maintain daily log of dishwasher operating temperatures and chemical levels.
- 6. Maintain daily log of refrigeration unit temperatures.
- 7. Remove trash and refuse from the kitchen and dining hall as needed.
- 8. Report group numbers to the Kitchen Manager.
- 9. Implement American Camp Association accreditation standards related to Food Service.
- 10. Abide by all regulations of the Virginia State Department of Health and the Rockingham County Health Department.
- 11. Help to plan and implement all-camp activities.
- 12. Participate in a weekly evaluation with the Kitchen Manager, Assistant Program Director, and/or Assistant Director.
- 13. Know the contents of the Staff Manual and abide by all camp policies and procedures.
- 14. Enforce camp policies, procedures, and health and safety regulations.
- 15. Assist in other areas of camp operation as needed.
