## BRETHREN WOODS CAMP AND RETREAT CENTER JOB DESCRIPTION

TITLE: Health Manager

RESPONSIBLE TO: Assistant Director, Director

PURPOSE: To serve as the primary medical person in charge of health care for all campers and staff members.

## **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Committed Christian with a willingness to accept the teachings of the Church of the Brethren.
- 2. Exhibit a spirit of cooperation and commitment to a team relationship with other camp staff.
- 3. Personable style and skills in relating to staff, guests, and campers.
- 4. A licensed physician, RN, LPN, EMT, or paramedic, with current First Aid and CPR certification from a nationally recognized provider, and able to supply documentation of licenses and certifications.
- 5. Attendance at one or more pre-camp training events.
- 6. Acceptance of Health Manager's responsibilities.

## RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Implement American Camp Association standards related to Health and Wellness and the Brethren Woods Camp and Retreat Center Health Care Plan.
- 2. Be on-site throughout the camp session.
- 3. Be responsible and in controlled possession of the health center, including supplies, equipment, and medications. Provide continual supervision of any persons in the health center.
- 4. Organize and direct the medical screening process.
- 5. Orient staff to any camper health concerns, restrictions, medications, disabilities, or general health needs.
- 6. Maintain accurate and up-to-date permanent medical record for all campers and staff. Keep accurate log of all services performed.
- 7. Determine medical conditions of campers and staff and advise Director or Assistant Director in the event of possible communicable disease, illness, or injury.
- 8. Keep all prescription medical supplies and administer as directed.
- 9. Maintain an inventory of health center materials and equipment. Order materials with the approval of the Assistant Director or Director.
- 10. Restock and maintain first aid kits.
- 11. Provide leaders of off-camp trips, departing in a vehicle, with copies of all health forms for campers and staff going on the trip.
- 12. Participate in a weekly evaluation with the Assistant Director and/or Director.
- 13. Know the contents of the Staff Manual and abide by all camp policies and procedures.
- 14. Enforce camp policies, procedures, and health and safety regulations.
- 15. Assist in other areas of camp operation as needed.
